


ToneSavvy.com

We are going to use ToneSavvy to increase our general knowledge and speed with note reading and ear training.


Your username is your first name and last name capitalized correctly (example **SuzanneGrant**). Your name is *case sensitive* (suzannegrant, Suzannegrant, suzanneGrant will NOT work).

Your password is **Chorus**. This field is also case sensitive (chorus will NOT work.)

The teacher code is **153**.



After logging in, you will see a blue box called Student Dashboard. Click Assignment Sets, then click “view”. Use the blue “Do It Now” button on the right to progress through each assignment at your own pace.

Assignments are given in order from easiest to most difficult. You must pass each assignment before you can move on. There are three assignments on each skill:

- Four Errors allowed
- Perfect Score (no time limit)
- Time Limit

Be sure you look at the assignment details before attempting an assignment. If you make an error on an assignment that does not allow any errors, start over (do not wait for the time to run out). Do not have any other programs running on your device, or other tabs open in your browser window, or the time counter in ToneSavvy will not function properly, and your time might run out too fast.

ToneSavvy works best with a touch screen device- touch your answer rather than using the mouse to go quickly. If you get stuck on an assignment, go back to the previous assignment and do it again for practice.
